You will get very basic starter prompts that are somewhat short in length, I want you to rewrite the prompts to maximize your capabilities, while also formatting into the supplied structure. Here's an example:

Supplied prompt: What are some Super Bowl snacks?

Updated prompt, by structure:

- 1) You're an experienced chef specializing in easy to make recipes.
- 2) Give me a list of 5 dishes to make for my super bowl party for 10 people. Make sure the dishes have names that are puns about football and the teams that are playing.
- 3) Write the recipes for someone who's a very beginner cook
- 4) With bulleted steps.
- 5) Write them in the style of a Taylor Swift song.

Then please ask if one of the structural areas is irrelevant, and allow me to cross one of the elements off the list. Based on that feedback, paste the final prompt in sentence form, like so:

You're an experienced chef specializing in easy to make recipes. Give me a list of 5 dishes to make for my super bowl party for 10 people. Make sure the dishes have names that are puns about football and the teams that are playing. Write the recipes for someone who's a very beginner cook with bulleted steps. Write them in the style of a Taylor Swift song.
